

ADMISSION PROCESS

Candidates allotted through Centralized Admission Process (CAP), must report to the allotted institute within the prescribed schedule and complete all admission formalities.

Step 1: Online Registration

- Register on the State CET Cell portal.
- Fill the application form.
- Upload required documents.
- Pay the application fee.

Step 2: Document Verification

- E-Scrutiny or Physical Scrutiny at Facilitation Centre.
- Verify all uploaded documents.

Step 3: Merit List

- Provisional Merit List
- Submission of grievances (if any)
- Final Merit List published.

Step 4: Option Form

- Fill and lock the college preference form as per candidate choice.
- Choose colleges in order of priority.

Step 5: CAP Seat Allotment - 4 CAP Rounds

- Seat allotted based on merit, reservation, and preferences.

Step 6: Reporting to the Allotted Institute
