## **Report of GPAT Guidance Session**

### **INTRODUCTION**

A guidance session on the **Graduate Pharmacy Aptitude Test (GPAT) & NIPER** was organized for B. Pharmacy students at AIMS College of Pharmacy. The session was conducted on **Saturday, 5th July 2025**, with the purpose of providing valuable insights into **GPAT preparation and career opportunities** after qualifying the exam. The guest speaker, **Mr. Sagar Gupta**, a team member of **PHARMAELITE**, shared his expertise and motivated the students to pursue higher education through entrance exams like GPAT and NIPER.

### **EXPLANATION**

Mr. Sagar Gupta began the session by introducing the Graduate Pharmacy Aptitude Test (GPAT) and its relevance for students aspiring to pursue postgraduate studies in pharmacy. He explained that GPAT is a national-level entrance exam conducted for admission into M. Pharmacy programs and also qualifies students for scholarships such as the AICTE PG Scholarship. He also spoke about NIPER (National Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and Research), highlighting its reputation and the importance of securing a good All India Rank (AIR) in GPAT to gain admission into these premier institutes.

He then provided a comprehensive overview of the GPAT syllabus, which includes major B. Pharm subjects such as Pharmacology, Pharmaceutics, Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Pharmacognosy, along with general aptitude and analytical reasoning. Mr. Gupta emphasized the need for focused and consistent preparation, suggesting that students identify high-weightage topics, refer to standard textbooks, and regularly solve previous years question papers and mock tests.

The session also stressed the significance of time management during both preparation and examination. Mr. Gupta shared practical tips such as creating daily study schedules, setting achievable goals, and allocating specific time slots for revision and mock practice. He explained how marks and AIR play a crucial role not just in admissions but also in availing government scholarships and research opportunities.

Towards the end, he provided insights into top institutes across India that accepts GPAT and NIPER scores. These included NIPERs (Mohali, Hyderabad, Ahmedabad, etc.), ICT Mumbai, Jamia Hamdard, BITS Pilani, among others. He also encouraged students to consider career paths in research, academia, and the pharmaceutical industry, all of which can be accessed more easily through a strong GPAT performance.
